The Princeville Civic Association (PCA) and the Village of Princeville are hosting a Tree Lighting and Holiday Stroll on Sunday, December 6th from 4:30-7pm. This event is an opportunity to start a new Princeville tradition, to provide a social event for area residents, and to support our local businesses. Join us for holiday fun for the whole family!

The Tree Lighting and Holiday Stroll will take place in Stevens Square and in the downtown area. Jon Blank is our MC for the tree lighting and will count down the event. Once the trees are lit, participants will be encouraged to stroll through the lights in the Square and in the downtown area.
