Tree Lighting Celebration: Sunday, December 6th from 4:30-7 p.m. The PCA will be setting our table up at the gazebo. The village will be closing the highway for the stroll. Jeff will inform the sheriff's office about this event. Introductions and tree lighting will be at approximately 4:40 by Jon Blank. Beth is working on the script for Jon. Unfortunately, the 14 -2nd grade Girl Scouts will be unable to attend and do the caroling. Kathy painted over wording on picture cut out to read "Princeville" so it may be used for other events. Santa will be walking around giving out candy canes. Boy Scouts will be handing out hot cocoa and doing a food drive. Lions Club will be serving food. Several businesses will be decorating and handing out goodies of their choice. We will be having an Ornament Hunt. Beth is making the ornaments on the library's 3D printer and handed out to the businesses. Sue is getting the gift cards and working with Jeff to get the bicycles from Seneca. Tiffany is putting together the basket. Sue, Beth, Tessa, and Tiffany decorated a couple of the store fronts for the Ornament Hunt. Press release – ran for two weeks in both papers for \$400.00. Members will meet at 3 p.m. at the Gazebo on Sunday to set up for the Tree Lighting.
