 - A. Friday night Showcase of Princeville talent, football auction, bible school and cheerleaders. Saturday: Marriage game 7-9pm. St. Jude is planning to do dunk tank. Amy suggested that they do prizes for dunked person with the most throws in a time slot. Will St. Jude runners also do bags tournament? Beth will check. Possibly car show on Saturday—Drew Black?

Cost would be about \$700. Jeff will contact the ambulance to see if they would share their fundraiser letter.
